

Solid Rock Ministries is a non-denominational Christian Ministry specifically for military wives.

Groups meet on various Bases with the local support of at least one Chaplain and under the wider covering of Solid Rock Ministries.

Solid Rock Ministries (SRM) began at the beginning of 2007 and partners with Military Christian Fellowship (a ministry to Defence since 1959). Unlike the Military Christian Fellowship, which supports military members, SRM's focus is military wives. We do, however, welcome involvement from female military members. Military wives and their children are most welcome at the Solid Rock groups.

In Townsville SRM meets at Lavarack Barracks Chaplaincy Centre each Tuesday morning during the school term.

The unique stresses and hardships that are placed upon military wives, particularly the difficulties associated with moving and with husband's deploying are recognised. Groups seek to be empathetic listening ear as well as an encouragement.

Solid Rock groups look at informal Bible studies based on the group's needs and interests. Social morning teas are held on the last Tuesday of each month.
