What is the Walk of Witness?

Walk of Witness is an international event. On Sunday May 16th the Combined Churches of Townsville saw the commencement of a week celebrating Christian unity across the world and locally celebrated by having a “Walk of Witness” in the city. Commencing in 2009 in Townsville, Walk of Witness recognises the power of Christians across denominations working, witnessing and walking together in our faith in our wider community.

In Townsville the leaders of the City's Churches have decided to show their unity by inviting Christians to join in a journey from St James Cathedral to the Sacred Heart Cathedral via Townsville Central City Mission, St Andrew's Presbyterian Church and the City Council building. It's a time where Christians can get together and express their unity in faith. As part of the Walk of Witness a cross is held at the front of the procession followed by a time of worship and prayer.
